

Alleluia!!! Per the directives of our New Jersey Bishops.

The dispensation from attending Mass has been lifted all Catholics are now obligated to attend Sunday, and Holy Days of obligations beginning on Saturday June 5, 2021 and Sunday June 6, 2021. We welcome our faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist.

- The EMC, Lectors, and Altar Servers who wish to return and the Altar Servers (with parental permission from their parent) can return by scheduling through Loren.
- The priest, deacons and altar servers will process normally in and out of Mass.
- We will continue with 4pm livestreaming of the Mass.
- We will continue with the overflow at Sunday Masses.
- We will **NOT** be distributing communion after 4pm mass on Saturday or after the 12pm mass on Sundays. (Last weekend is 5/29-30)
- *The obligation does not apply to those that are ill, those recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness, those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health condition. (canon 87) If you request the Body of Christ, please call the parish office and the staff will add your name to the list for receiving Jesus.*
- *For the offertory procession families to speak with the ushers if you wish to participate.*
- *The sign of Peace will return to pre-pandemic if you and others wish to touch. Please understand if others choose not to.*

EMC:

- We will NOT be distributing the Eucharist under both species. **(No Precious Blood)**
- TWO more hand sanitizing tables will be in the sanctuary for communion stations for proper hand sanitizing before, during

and after communion. ONE table will be in Marian Hall for the overflow.

Lectors:

- Returning forward to pre-pandemic world. To sit with your family and or sit in the first-row choir side that is reserved for the lectors and EMC,

Ushers-Greeters:

- Welcome our faithful back.
- Assist them if needed.
- Offer Holy Water sprayed on parishioners' hands if they wish.
- Collections will resume normally per the pre-pandemic, including first and second collection per pre-pandemic norms, ushers will collect 1st collection and bring up during the offertory and second collection after communion.
- Faithful can exit the door of their choice or any door.
- Bulletins will be given at all doors.
- If you can help sanitizing the church after Mass would be so appreciated.
