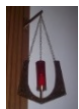

Following Father’s talk on God’s Mercy there will be Confession.

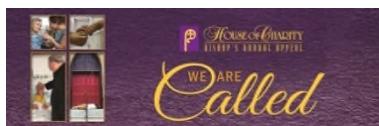

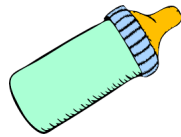

RCIT is the program that can fully enable a person to embark on this journey. RCIT is the "RCIA" (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) program geared towards high school or college-aged teens and young adults.
