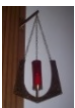


“COULD GOD BE CALLING YOU TO THE PRIESTHOOD?”

New Jersey Postcard
Campaign in Support of the
NJ Pain Capable Child
Protection Act (A1686/S537)

The New Jersey Catholic Conference of Bishops has approved a statewide postcard campaign urging our State Senators/Members of the NJ State Assembly to support the *NJ Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (A1686/S537)*. If passed, this bill would protect babies in the womb at 20 weeks post-fertilization; that is, 5 months old and beyond, from being aborted. Our parish will have the opportunity to sign postcards at all masses, on the weekend of October 5-6, to be sent to our state legislators.

This legislation has already been successfully passed in at least 21 states.

Many babies at 20 weeks could live outside the womb if given proper medical care. At 20 weeks, babies in the womb are fully formed, can feel pain, and have all of their vital organs which are fully formed and functioning.

Please consider signing three (3) postcards (one for your State Senator, and two for your representatives in the State Assembly) at the mass you attend on the weekend of October 5-6. Postcards will be provided in the pews of all masses that weekend.
